The I/O unit BN-320 is connected to the detector loop to control, monitor or identify external equipment. Typical applications are:

The unit has been designed for use with Autronica's interactive fire detection systems, and comprise the SelfVerify function. This function ensures the highest grade of reliability and reduces the need for manual testing, because all units comprising this function are automatically checked once every 24 hours.

Note:

External units require 24 V working voltage (cannot be powered by the detector loop).

Principle

The unit has two (2) monitored inputs, one (1) out-put, and will occupy one address on the detector loop.

SelfVerify: the ability to initiate alarm signal is regularly checked.


